- All projects have a Knowledge and Learning (K&L) component

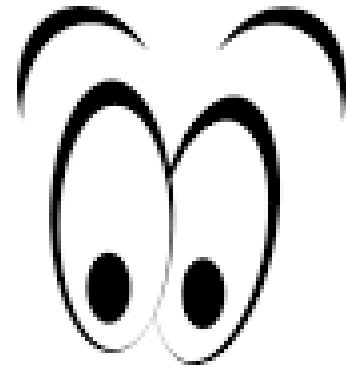
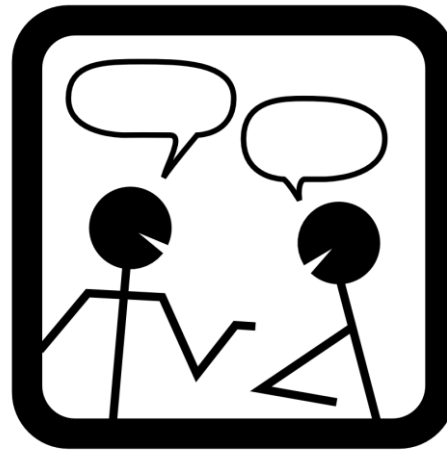
## Fund-wide K&L component

  3. Share knowledge and learning between CSOs and with the wider WASH sector

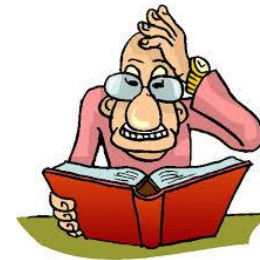

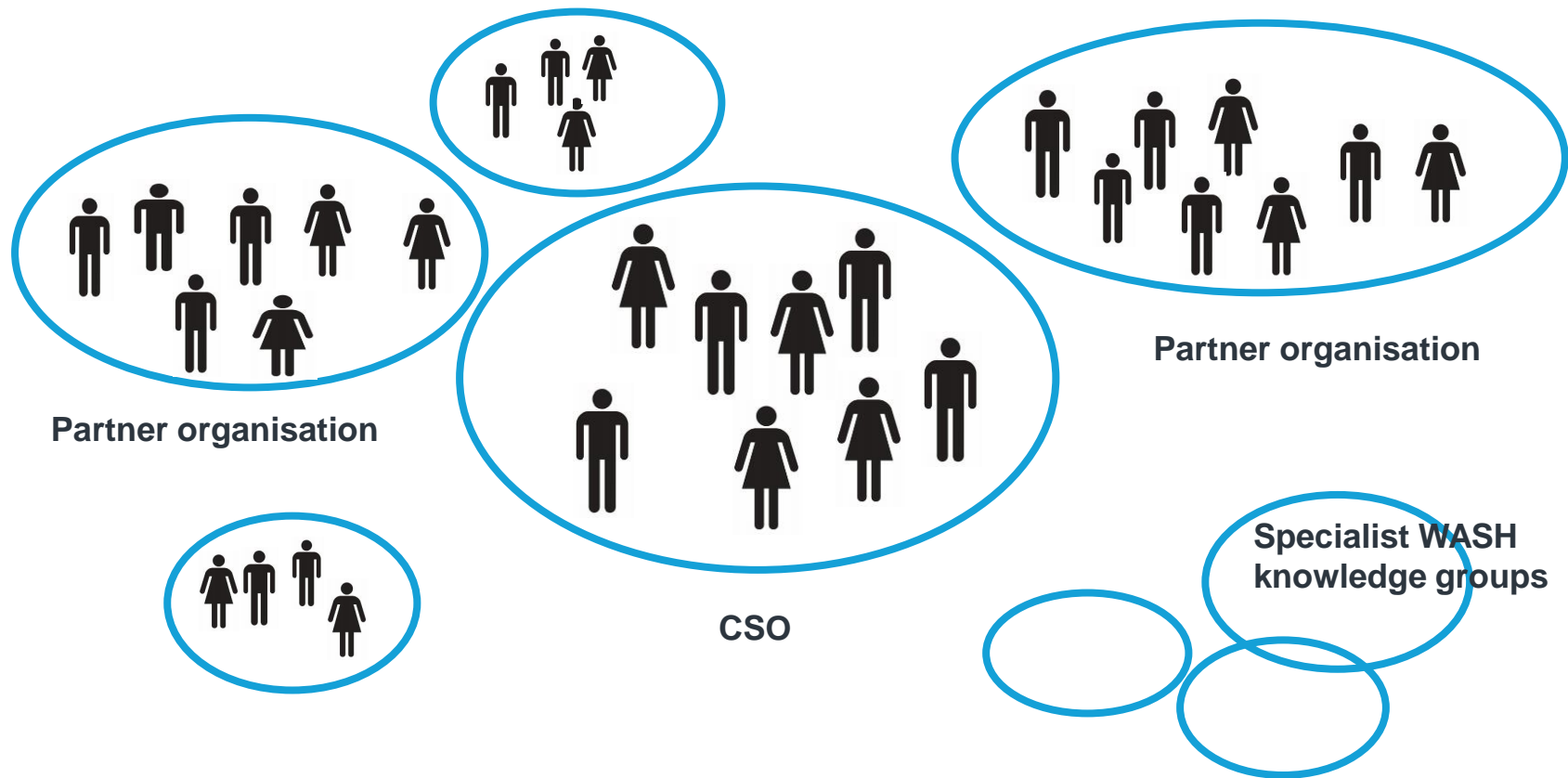

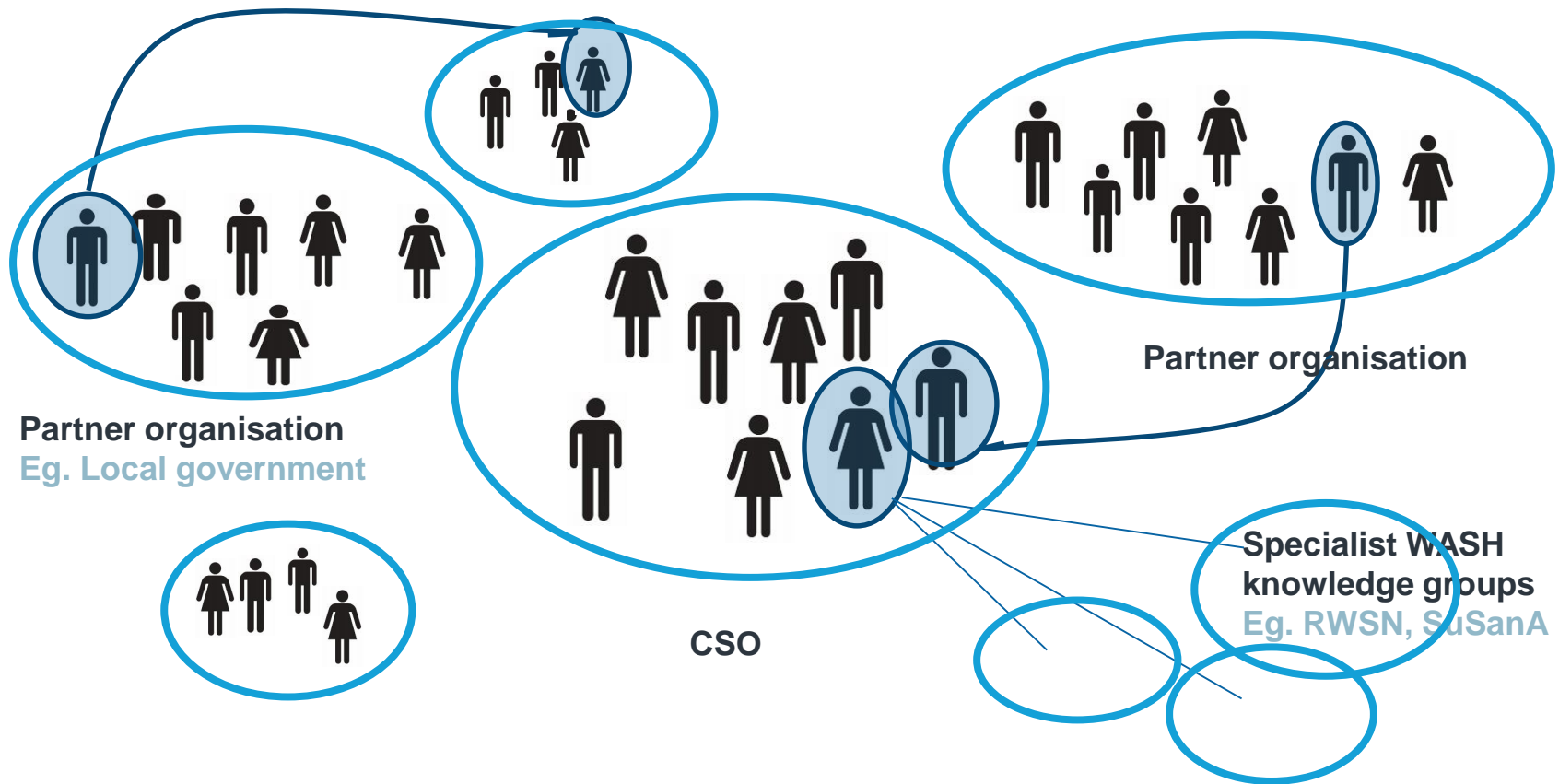

# How do we as WASH practitioners interact, learn and improve?

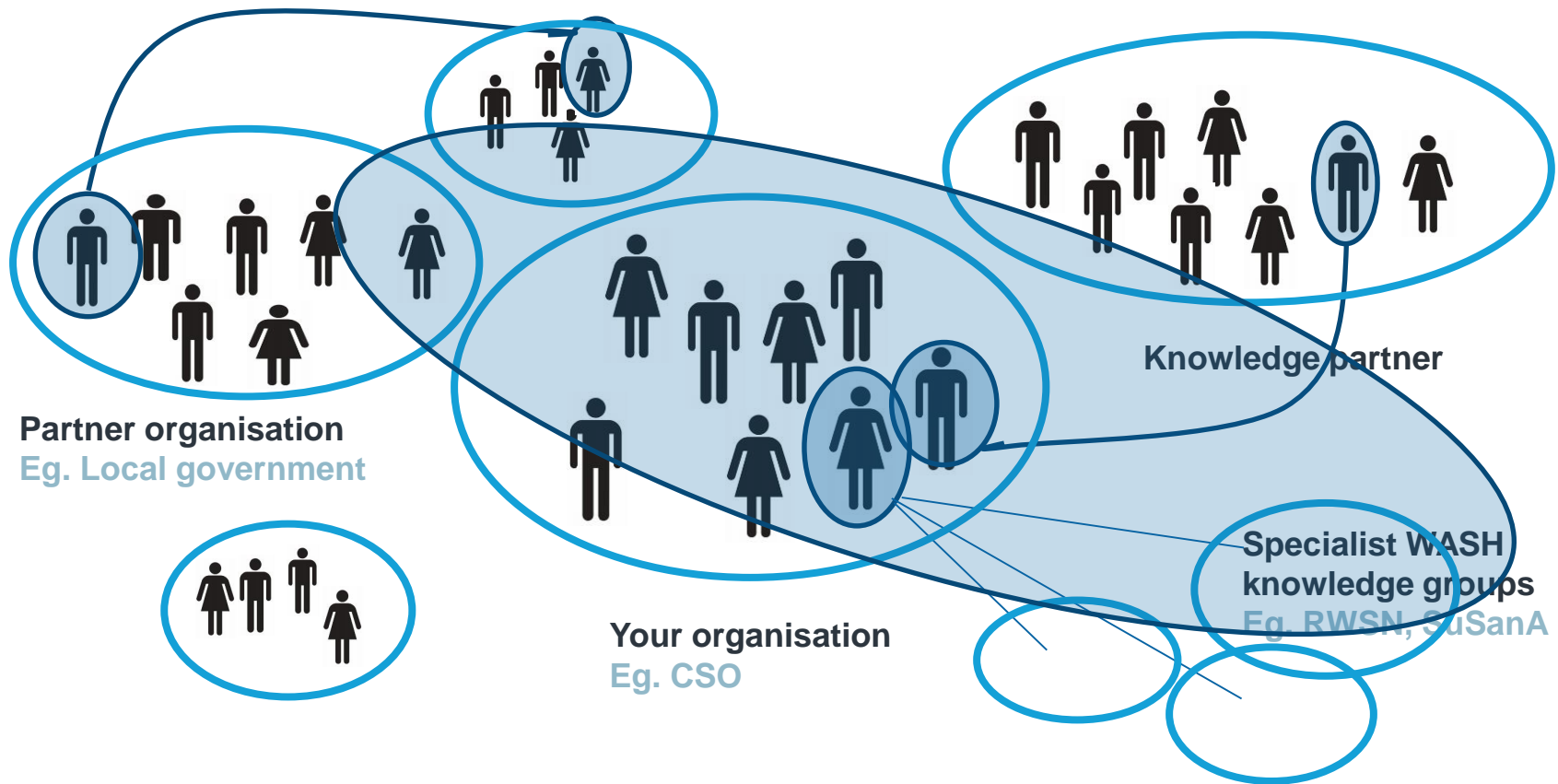


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# Community of Practice

Communities of practice are groups of people who share a concern or a passion for something they do and learn how to do it better as they interact regularly.

The practice of a community is dynamic and involves learning on the part of everyone.

# CSO Learning for Impact

## Research questions

1. **How do CSOs learn and improve WASH programming and practice to align with evidence-based approaches?**
2. **What materials, formats and communications mechanisms are most preferred in influencing CSO learning?**
3. **What materials, formats and communication mechanisms are most effective and innovative in improving CSO WASH program in alignment with good practice?**



# What enables learning within CSOs?

## Findings

1. Opportunities for **peer-to-peer learning**
2. Time for **reflection processes**
3. **Leadership** driving a learning culture
4. Knowledge and learning duties identified in work-plans
5. Time to engage with **networks**
6. Adequate **resources** (time and funding)

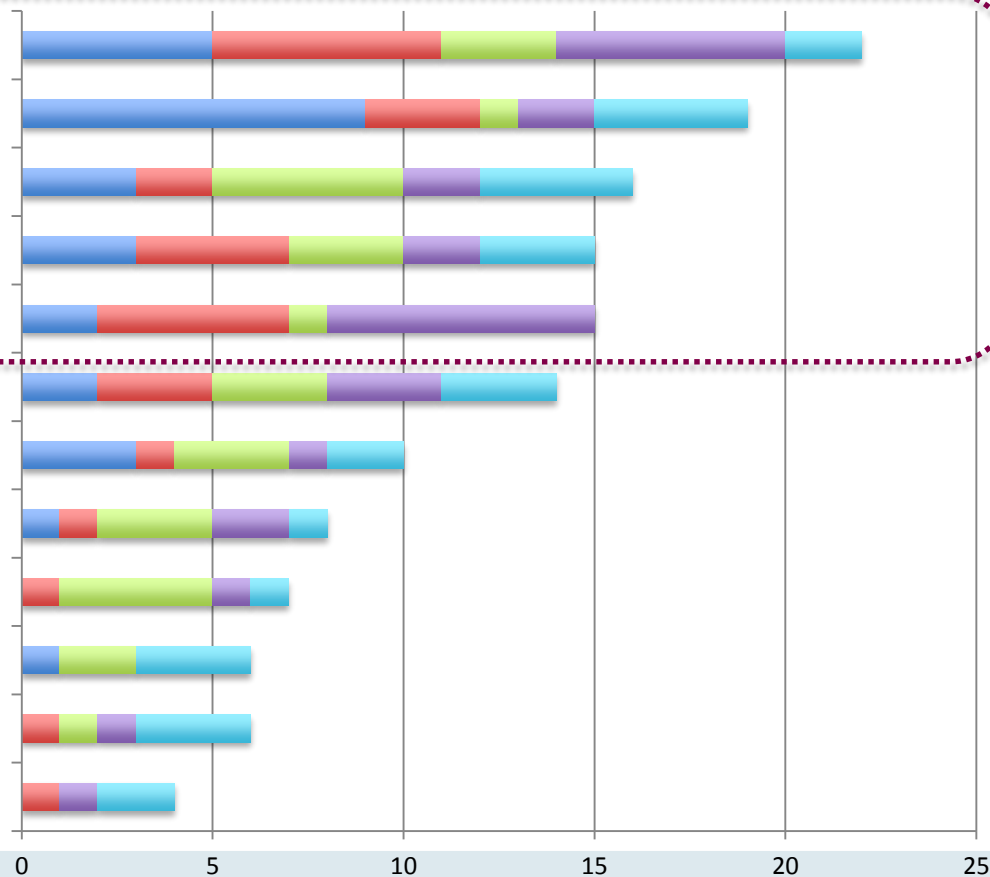

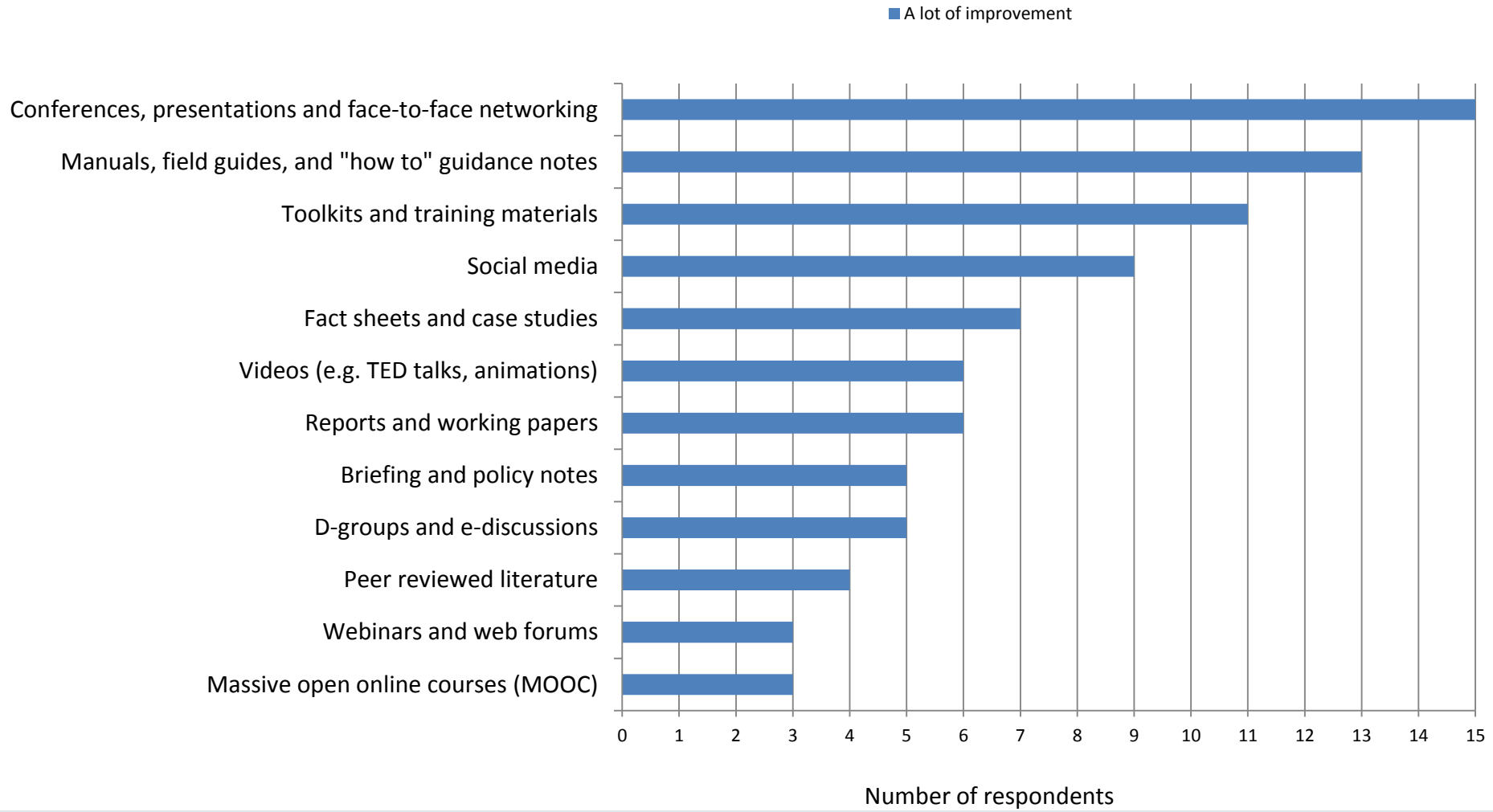

- Smart subsidies for rural sanitation - Cambodia. iDE/ Causal Design

Another in East Asia region

- Strategic gender impacts in WASH – Vietnam. Plan/ISF UTS

## Civil Society Innovation Award

1. Nudging for handwashing in schools. Save the Children Bangladesh
2. Low cost solutions for Faecal Sludge Management. Water for People Uganda
3. Sanitation solutions for floating communities. Wetland Work! Cambodia
